Description and how to apply

Probationary tenancies (3rd six pupillages) are unfunded, and the successful candidate will be expected to generate their own income from our caseload. The probationary period will last for up to 6 months, with an option after 4 months to assess progress. Successful applicants can expect to be busy and in court regularly. They will be supported by efficient and professional staff. We would expect to want to take up references from earlier pupillages. Applications should be made by covering letter and your CV with full details of the work you have undertaken during your pupillage to date and the details of two referees – one of these should preferably be a previous Pupil Supervisor. All applications will be treated in the strictest confidence.
